

ASCE Pittsburgh Section SMART Goal III 2015-2018

Specific – WHO? WHAT?

The ASCE Pittsburgh Section will support national infrastructure efforts on the Highway Trust Fund, the Pennsylvania Report Card, Water Resources Development Act, and the Federal Aviation Administration Reauthorization.

Measurement/Assessment – HOW?

We will continue to sponsor a Section Key Contact Champion, State Advocacy Captain, and Federal Advocacy Captain to participate in Infrastructure Day, Washington DC Fly-in and at least one regional meeting approved by the Board of Directors. In return, these officers will provide timely information and policy support to the Section Institute Chapters so that Section members can be better aware and engaged in the national infrastructure efforts. This will be accomplished with:

- A minimum of one article every other month for our news and/or blog from at least one of these volunteers;
- A minimum of one “Back Home” visit organized by the Champion and/or Captains during a given fiscal year; and,
- The Champion and Captains continuously mentoring other volunteers to continue their efforts beyond their term.

Attainable/Achieve – REASONABLE?

The Pittsburgh Section already has a Section Key Contact Champion, State Advocacy Captain, and Federal Advocacy Captain and already report to the Board of Directors. Starting in the Fall of 2015, one of these volunteers will attend the Board meetings or submit updates of on-going efforts – including contacting Senators and Congressmen, attending summits, raising awareness (through networks), articles for the News Blog and “Back Home” visits.

Relevant – EXPECTED RESULT?

The Section will increase the participation of our Technical Institutes members and their networks, including public officials, by at least 10%.

Timed – WHEN?

The Section is targeting reaching this goal by 2018.
