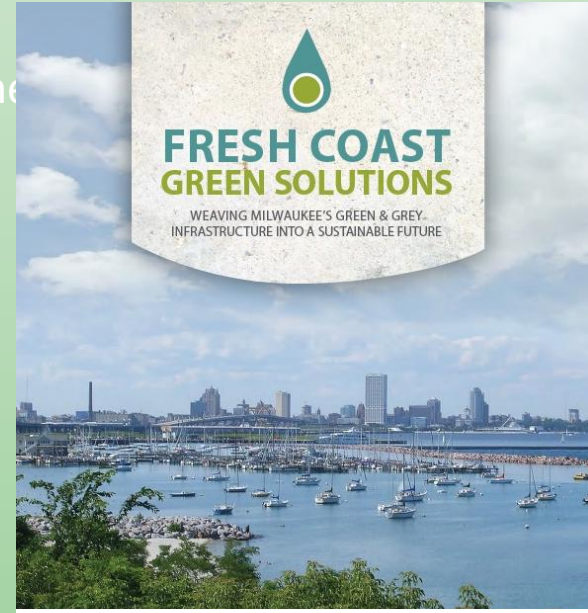
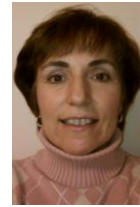
**Annual CSO Event:

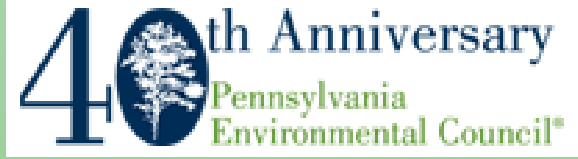
