Mary Ellen has been the Borough Manager for Etna for the past 32 years and with the Borough for a total of 45 years and is a life-long resident of Etna Borough.

Mary Ellen was a founding member of the North Hills Council of Governments Storm Water Management Committee and serves as Chair of that Committee. She is the Treasurer/Secretary for CONNECT, a multi-municipal organization/collaboration between the City of Pittsburgh and the urban core communities which surround the City of Pittsburgh. Mary Ellen is a founding member of the Etna Community Organization, which spearheaded the Etna EcoDistrict, the first certified EcoDistrict in the world and serves as Vice President of that organization. She currently serves on the ALCOSAN Advisory Committee and the 3 Rivers Wet Weather Consent Order Committee. She spearheaded the adoption of the Boroughs Green Master Plan and has managed the implementation of six of those projects in the community, one of which won the Governor's Award for Environmental Excellence in 2014. She also serves as the Borough's Community Rating System Coordinator, which assisted the Borough with lowering their ISO Flood Insurance Rating to a Class 7, providing 15% discount on flood insurance premiums to Etna's residents. She also serves on the Board of Tree Pittsburgh.
